- To foster the pan-orthodox cooperation between societies from the University of Nottingham that have orthodox members (e.g.: Hellenic, Russian, Romanian, Bulgarian, Arabic, Cypriot, Egyptian, Slavonic, Lithuanian, Lebanese, Syrian);
- To liaise and foster links with other Orthodox youth and student organizations from UK and overseas.

The society shall abide by any applicable laws, by-laws and guidelines of the Students Union within the University of Nottingham.
